What am I?**

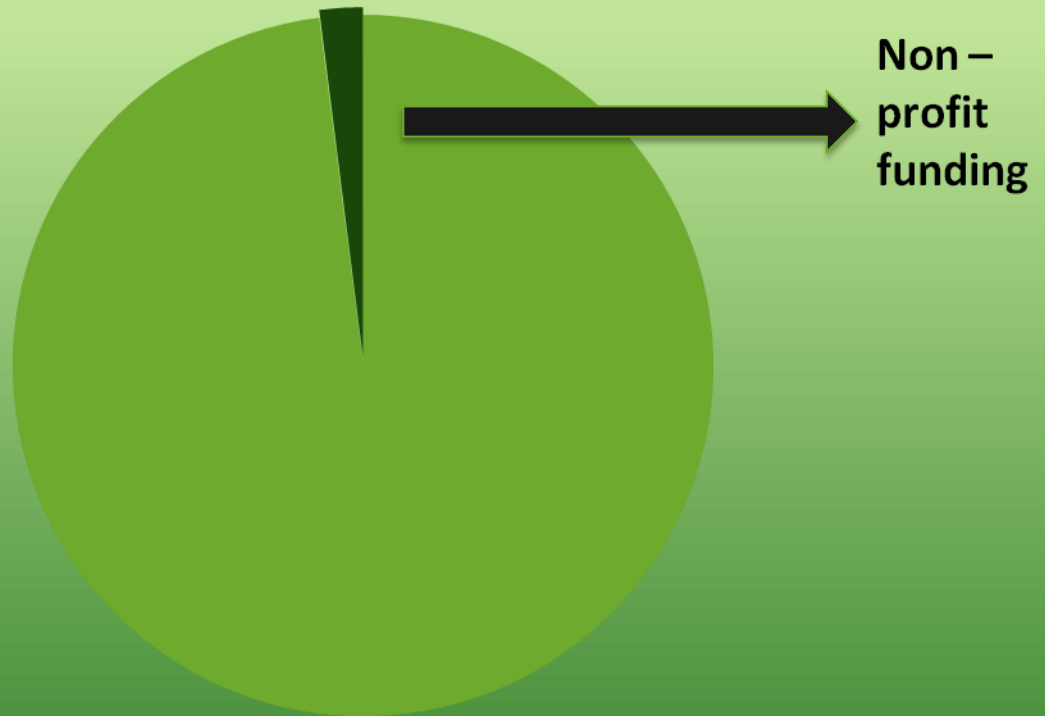
Jeopardy – Category is “Manitoba Farmers”
